Only Bidders that have the required Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) Grading as per the table above are eligible to submit Bids. Joint Ventures are also eligible to submit Bids provided that every member of the Joint Venture is registered with the CIDB and a combined grade of the Joint Venture calculated in accordance with the CIDB regulations is equal to or higher than the specified Contractor grading.

Bid documents may be obtained after 08h00 on Monday, 18 September 2017 from the offices of the Mtubatuba Municipality, at LOT 105 Inkosi Mtubatuba Road, Mtubatuba upon payment of the non-refundable cash payment of R 650.00 (Six Hundred and Fifty Rand) VAT inclusive per set.

A compulsory clarification meeting will be held at the Mtubatuba Municipality Council Chamber, at LOT 105 Inkosi Mtubatuba Road, Mtubatuba on Tuesday, 26 September 2017 at 11H00. The meeting will be followed by a visit to the Mtubatuba Traffic Management Centre.

Proposal are to be completed in accordance with the conditions attached to the bid documents.

The procedure for evaluation of responsive tender offers will be Method 1: Financial Offer and Preference. Quality (functionality) will be used as a prequalifying criteria, with tenderers required to meet a minimum quality score of 60 points. Qualifying tenderers will be evaluated using the 80/20 Preference Point System for Financial Offer and Preference. The Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) and Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 apply to this tender
